

SUGGESTED QUESTIONS FOR THE PERUVIAN STATE

I. The Right to Health Free from Discrimination: Inability to Access Therapeutic Abortion

- What actions has the Peruvian state adopted for complying with applicable United Nations Committee Resolutions in the K.L. and L.C. cases regarding lack of access to legal therapeutic abortion, both in terms of reparations to the victims as well as measures for ensuring that such cases do not repeat themselves?
- What measures is Peru taking for the adoption of a protocol for the performance of therapeutic abortions that includes clear mechanisms for accessing said procedure, while respecting a broad interpretation of its scope in regards to the physical and mental protection of women, especially girls and teens?

II. The Right to Health Free from Discrimination: Legal Barriers against Teen Access to Sexual and Reproductive Health Services

- What measures has Peru adopted for reversing the adverse normative framework, which translates into legal barriers that prevent teenagers from obtaining sexual and reproductive prevention and care services?
- What actions are prioritized by the Peruvian State to address the high rate of teenage pregnancies and ensure the accessibility and availability of sexual and reproductive health services, including delivery attendance, institutional birth services and emergency contraceptives, particularly in rural areas?

III. The Right to be Free from Discrimination: Violence against Gays, Lesbians, Bisexuals, and Trans and legal framework against discrimination

- What is Peru doing to expedite the adoption of specific legislation prohibiting discrimination against persons based on sexual orientation and to take measures, in particular awareness-raising, to ensure that LGBT persons are not discriminated against on the basis of their sexual orientation and gender identity (for example Bill N° 756/2011-CR)?
- What measures has Peru adopted to expedite laws for preventing and increasing sentences for discrimination based crimes against gays, lesbians, bisexuals, and trans (for example Bill N° 609/2011-CR)?
- What public policies does the Peruvian State intend to implement for preventing, recording, and punishing acts of violence against gay, lesbian, bisexual, and trans individuals?
