AMENDMENTS TO BOARD PROPOSALS FOR AMENDING THE CONSTITUTION

BC 1.1 Proposed amendment to BC1 (C6.1.3) from Netwerk Roze FNV

Comment on wording proposed for C6.1.3 point c)

We think that the initiatives should be at global level, not the articles itself (since ILGA is already a world-wide organisation).

Proposed amendment

Amend the proposed text for C6.1.3 point c) to read:

c. Initiate, on a global scale, articles on women's issues for ILGA publications;

Warning: If this change is accepted, it should have also have consequences for the clauses about the other Committees.

BC 1.2 Proposed amendment to BC1 (C6.5.2) from NSW LGBTI Legal Forum

In the proposed text for C6.5.2, delete "30" and replace with "24"

BC 1.3 Proposed amendment to BC1 (C6.5.3) from Netwerk Roze FNV

<u>Comment</u>

Text processing error: clause C6.5.3 c) is about youth, and not on bisexuals.

Proposed amendment

To amend the proposed text to read:

c) Initiate, on a global scale, articles on youth issues for ILGA publications;

BC 1.2 Proposed amendment to BC1 (C6.5) from NSW LGBTI Legal Forum

Add new clause:

C6.5.4 The definition of "youth" is based on the United Nations definition for youth i.e. 15-24 years

BC 2.1 Proposed amendment to BC2 from Netwerk Roze FNV

<u>Comments</u>

- 1. There can be a big discussion on whether religion is an ideology or not. We think the word ideological is unnecessary.
- 2. The main part of the Constitution is written in British English. Let us avoid mixing different styles of English.

Proposed amendment

To amend the proposed text as follows:

Seeking in ILGA an international organi<u>s</u>ation within which lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans and intersex people from different ideological perspectives (for example, religion, separatism, feminism etc.) can work together,

BC 3.1.1 Proposed amendment to BC3.1 from Netwerk Roze FNV

<u>Comment</u>

We strongly believe that we should work not only for those who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans or intersex. For instance, we consider MSM (= men having sex with men) also a target group for the work of ILGA. If ILGA would only work for the liberation of those who identify as LGBTI, we would be very disappointed.

Proposed amendment

To amend the proposed text as follows:

To work for the equality of lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans and intersex people and for <u>the</u> liberation from all forms of discrimination;
